1 JUN WEDNESDAY: Depart for Israel!

2 JUN THURSDAY: AIRPORT TO TEL AVIV:

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to Jerusalem hotel for a welcome by pilgrimage staff and Mass and short orientation. Dinner & overnight Jerusalem. D

3 JUN FRIDAY: BETHLEHEM:

Enter Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity and see the birthplace of Jesus, followed by Mass at St. Catherine's. Stop at the Shepherds' Fields before shopping at a Christian gift shop. On the return to Jerusalem, we stop at the Church of the Gallicantu, which commemorates Peter's denial of Christ. There we view Jesus' prison cell and the Roman stairs where Jesus walked at the House of Caiaphas. Dinner & overnight Jerusalem. B L D

4 JUN SATURDAY: JERUSALEM:

View panorama of city from the Mt. of Olives, then walk down to Dominus Flevit, a chapel recalling when Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Continue walking down the Mt. of Olives to the Garden of Gethsemane for Mass at the Church of All Nations and view the stone where Jesus sweat drops of blood. After lunch, we visit the Israel museum to view the model of 1st Century Jerusalem. Later we visit the Upper Room on the Eve of Pentecost, the site of the Last Supper and the Day of Pentecost, and then walk to Dormition Abbey, the site of Mary's Assumption. Dinner & overnight Jerusalem. B L D

5 JUN SUNDAY: JERUSALEM on Day of Pentecost:

Start the morning with the Via Dolorosa, the walk of Christ's Passion ending up at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the site of Christ's crucifixion and resurrection. Visit the Jewish Quarter, Western Wall followed by optional free time in the Old City. Evening Mass and concert at King of Kings Auditorium in Jerusalem. Dinner & overnight Jerusalem. B L D

6 JUN MONDAY: JERUSALEM:

Visit the Davidson Center to explore the area south of the Temple Mount, then gather at the Southern Steps for teaching by Jeff. Visit the City of David and walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel (the channel we walk through has shallow water in it) to the Pool of Siloam. Drive to the site of Emmaus outside Jerusalem for Mass and then stop to visit Ein Kerem, the site of the Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth. NOTE: Need to pack for Bedouin overnight in small bag and swim attire for Dead Sea and Sachne Springs. Dinner and overnight Jerusalem. B L D

7 JUN TUESDAY: DEAD SEA AREA:

Drive to En Gedi, wilderness site where David hid from King Saul. Jeff will give a teaching. Optional hike to falls. Stop for a Dead Sea swim before a lunch stop and visit to Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scrolls discovery. Arrive at Bedouin camp for overnight. Possible camel rides. After Mass and dinner, enjoy an Evening Concert with our featured musician. NOTE: pack swim clothes in your day pack for tomorrow. Dinner & overnight Kfar Hanokim. B L D

8 JUN WEDNESDAY: DESERT to GALILEE:

Drive to Qsar El Yehud, the baptismal site of Jesus on the Jordan River to hear a teaching by Jeff and for Mass & renewal of baptismal promises. Drive to Galilee. Relax at Sachne Springs for a swim and lunch. Stop at either archaeological site of Beth Shean or Megiddo. Dinner & overnight Sea of Galilee. B L D

9 JUN THURSDAY: GALILEE:

Drive to Nazareth for Mass at the Church of the Annunciation and a visit to Mt. Precipice for a teaching by Fr. Mike. Visit Kfar Kedem for hands on fun in recreated first century farm, includes lunch. Dinner followed by outdoor Evening Concert with featured musicians & overnight Galilee. B L D

10 JUN FRIDAY: GALILEE:

Begin the day at St Peter's Primacy with the chance to renew our commitment as disciples, our continued commitment to chastity and if applicable marriage or religious vows. Next we spend time on the of Mount of Beatitudes in meditation and participating in Mass. An optional walk from the Mt. of Beatitudes to Capernaum begins a free afternoon in the Galilee with time for a swim or the option for rafting on the Jordan River (added cost). Weather permitting, a bonfire with confessions along the seashore after dinner. Dinner & overnight Galilee. B L D

11 JUN SATURDAY: GALILEE:

We drive north to Caesarea Philippi for a teaching by Jeff on the papacy. A short drive to Tel Dan to view two city gates. One from the Israelite period and one from the time of Abraham. Hike a nature path to the High Place. Enjoy a St. Peter's Fish lunch on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Tour the site of Capernaum and participate in Mass at St. Peter's Church, built over the actual home of St. Peter. Hear a teaching about discipleship and view the location of the synagogue. Stop at the Ancient Boat Museum to see a boat from the time of Jesus. Then embark on an actual boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Dinner & overnight Galilee. B L D

12 JUN SUNDAY: GALILEE EN ROUTE TO AIRPORT:

As we leave the Galilee, we stop to visit the archaeological site of Magdala, the town of Mary Magdalene. Stop at Druze Village for lunch. Then we head down the Mediterranean Coast to Caesarea Maritima for farewell teaching in the theater built by Herod the Great. Last view of the land from the town of Jaffa with time for our farewells. We end the day at the airport. B L

13 JUN MONDAY: HOME:

Arrive home with wonderful memories of the Holy Land.
