Father Ryan serves as chaplain at Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas. He graduated *summa cum laude* in 2003 from Loyola University in New Orleans where he obtained a B.B.A. in Economics. In 2016, he was ordained to the priesthood and graduated *summa cum laude* with degrees in Philosophy and Theology from the Pontifical Athenaeum Regina Apostolorum. He has since served as chaplain of Young Catholic Professionals in Dallas, Texas and a spiritual director for FOCUS New Staff Training.

This active program covers a good amount of ground each day. You need to be able to walk for 60 minutes straight and on uneven surfaces. Some stairs will be encountered.

This itinerary was created taking into account the "Holy Land Pilgrimage Guidelines" of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

Itinerary

✠ June 1, Wednesday, Day 1: DEPART USA

Depart a NYC area international airport on an overnight flight to Tel Aviv. Dinner and breakfast are served on the flight. Domestic add-on flights are available upon request. Upgrades to premium economy and business class are available upon request.

✠ June 2, Thursday, Day 2: ARRIVAL TEL AVIV – CAESAREA MARITIMA* – SEA OF GALILEE

Upon arrival, we are greeted by our English - speaking Christian tour guide and assisted with customs and passport control. We stop for coffee at the port of Caesarea Maritima before visiting the ancient ruins including the theatre, Herod's Palace, the Hippodrome, as well as the ports and aqueducts. Depart for our hotel on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. We celebrate Mass and have an orientation before dinner. Enjoy a well-deserved night of rest. Buffet dinner and overnight at the Sea of Galilee. (D)

* The program on this day will depend on the flight arrival time.

✠ June 3, Friday, Day 3: NAZARETH – CANA – NAIM

After breakfast, which is included each morning, we visit the Church of Annunciation where we celebrate Mass. Continue to Mary's Well and St. Joseph's Church. We stop at Mt. Precipice, where we have a great view of the Jezreel Valley and teaching by Jeff. The angry multitudes wanted to throw Jesus from this mountain after his teaching at the Nazareth Synagogue. We visit Nazareth Village for lunch. According to Luke, the village of Naim (Nain) was one of the cities in Galilee where Jesus toured, accompanied by his 12 apostles and assistant women, in the summer of 29AD (approximate date). During this visit he performed a miracle, bringing back to life the only son of a widow. We see the village of Naim and may walk on the Gospel Trail where Jesus and his disciples would have walked. Our next stop is Cana of Galilee, the site of Jesus' first miracle, where couples have an opportunity to renew their wedding vows. Be sure to bring your wedding rings and dress up for this special occasion. Dinner and overnight at the Sea of Galilee. (B, L D)

✠ June 4, Saturday, Day 4: MAGDALA – CAESAREA PHILIPPI – MT. TABOR

Today, we start the day with Mass at Magdala followed by a tour of the excavations of a First Century synagogue. Next, we visit Caesarea Philippi and Baniyas to see the source of the Jordan River and hear Jeff teach on the papacy. Continue to Mount Tabor for a stunning view from the Church of Transfiguration. Dinner and overnight at the Sea of Galilee. (B, D)

✠ June 5, Sunday, Day 5: JESUS MINISTRY AT THE SEA OF GALILEE

We enjoy a morning boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, followed by a visit to see the "Jesus Boat," a fishing vessel dating back to the time of Jesus. Continue the day with a visit to the beautiful Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus taught his followers. We celebrate Mass on the hill overlooking the peaceful waters of the Sea of Galilee. Enjoy a lunch of St. Peter's Fish before departing for Capernaum, home to Peter and one of the first towns where the gospel was preached. Next, we visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter, situated on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Our last stop is the Church of Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. Return to our hotel for dinner. Dinner and overnight at the Sea of Galilee. (B, L, D)

✠ June 6, Monday, Day 6: BAPTISMAL SITE OF JESUS – JERICHO- DEAD SEA

After breakfast, we depart Galilee for Qasr al-Yahud, located in the wilderness part of the Jordan River, thought to be the authentic place where John the Baptist baptized Jesus. Continue to Jericho, the oldest continuously inhabited city in the world, where we celebrate Mass. We see the Mt. of Temptation in the distance and Tel Jericho. Enjoy a lunch of local dishes accompanied by freshly baked bread. After lunch, we drive to the Dead Sea to take a dip in the mineral-filled waters and shop for Dead Sea Products. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B, L, D)

✠ June 7, Tuesday, Day 7: JERUSALEM: MT. OF OLIVES – MT. ZION

We start our day on Mt. of Olives. Explore Ascension Chapel and visit the Church of Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer. Marvel at the panoramic view from the Mt. of Olives of the eternal golden city. We walk along Palm Sunday Road, stopping at Dominus Fleuit where Jesus wept over the city. Then continue along the Jewish cemetery with a view over the Eastern Gate. See the Garden of Gethsemane and the Basilica of Agony, where we

celebrate Mass. In the afternoon, we drive to Mt. Zion where we visit St. Peter in Gallicantu, the Upper Room, and Dormition Abbey. Tonight's dinner is at leisure with an opportunity to taste some of the great food located in one of the many restaurants near your hotel. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B)

✚ June 8, Wednesday, Day 8: JERUSALEM: SOUTHERN STEPS OF THE TEMPLE, HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL, POOL OF SILOAM

We start our day with a visit to the Davidson Center to sit on the very steps to the Temple Mount that Jesus, Mary, Joseph, and the Apostles walked. Hear an inspiring teaching by Jeff. We walk a short distance to the City of David excavations before entering the ancient water tunnel built by King Hezekiah. At the exit of the tunnel sits the Pool of Siloam, where Jeff will give a brief teaching. Join Emily after dinner for a special presentation on the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, which we will see on Friday. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, D)

✚ June 9, Thursday, Day 9: BETHLEHEM – SHEPHERDS' FIELD – MEET THE CHRISTIANS OF THE HOLY LAND: SHARING THE BREAD

After breakfast, we visit the grotto of Christ's birth at the Church of the Nativity and have Mass at the Church of St. Catherine next door. Continue to Shepherds' Field for teaching by Jeff. After lunch, we visit a Christian cooperative store and shop in support of the Christian families in Bethlehem. Tonight, we enjoy meeting the Christians of Bethlehem in their homes and Sharing the Bread with them. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, L, Special dinner)

✚ June 10, Friday, Day 10: THE HOLY CITY: VIA DOLOROSA – WESTERN WALL – ST. ANNE'S CHURCH

The hotel will prepare a boxed breakfast for us and coffee before we depart early this morning to the Holy City. We pray the Stations of the Cross as we walk along the Via Dolorosa, ending with Mass in the Church of the Holy Sepulchre followed by a tour of the Church with time to venerate the place of Christ's crucifixion and resurrection. Today in the Old City, our lunch is falafel or shawarma, traditional Middle Eastern fast food. We walk through the Jewish Quarter to the Temple Mount area to visit the holy site of the Jewish people, the Western Wall, and tuck a prayer into the wall just as St. John Paul II did before us. We see the nearby Dome of the Rock, a holy site for Muslims. Visit St. Anne's Church and see the Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed the Paralytic. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, L, D)

✚ June 11, Saturday, Day 11: ISRAEL MUSEUM – EIN KEREM

This morning we drive to the Israel Museum to see the Jerusalem model and Shrine of the Book, containing the Dead Sea Scroll fragments. Our next stop is Ein Kerem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist to see the Church of Visitation and St. John's Grotto. We celebrate Mass in this sacred spot. Tonight enjoy a farewell dinner with local wine. (B, Farewell dinner)

✚ June 12, Sunday, Day 12: RETURN TO USA

We arrive home today following our amazing Holy Land adventure.

Your passport must be valid through December 12, 2022. Reservations will not be processed until we have passport copies. Prices quoted are based on payments by check. Prices: \$4,995.00 for the complete package; \$3,995.00 for land only (air not included); additional \$1,095.00 for solo travel (in room by yourself). For credit card payments add 4%.

Pilgrimage prices: Prices are based on minimum 30 passengers. Prices may be adjusted in the event of fewer than 30 passengers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices are in US dollars.

Solo Travel: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

Land Only Option: Land only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time, otherwise, transfers are not included.

Tour Cancellation Policy: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 90 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure all payments are non-refundable regardless of reason for cancellations. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection. Refer to the U.S. Policy by State on our website.

Trip Cancellation Protection: We strongly encourage you to purchase a **Travel Protection Plan**, for the protection of your travel investment. Please consider purchasing this plan at the time of initial deposit in order to be covered for pre-existing conditions. Please note that CFAR is not available in NY State. The plans contain insurance benefits underwritten by the United States Fire Insurance Company. Airline, seating and special requests: To best accommodate our pilgrims, we often utilize Group Air Reservations. These allow more predictable transfer and tour schedules. However, when booking Group Air, the airline (not Select International Tours)

controls seating assignments. If you require very specific seats, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options. You may communicate directly with the airline to request seating changes, provide mileage program information, or change passenger contact information once you receive ticket numbers—approximately three (3) weeks prior to departure. We work with instant purchase airline tickets and or group rates. If you switch from air and land to land only within 90 days from departure you will be charged a \$100 service fee in addition to any airline charges. All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be requested in writing at least 60 days prior to departure. Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request; as are add-ons from your hometown airport. If you require very specific airlines or schedules, we suggest that you book your own airfare and take advantage of our "Land Only" options.

Walking: Our trips require daily walking, sometimes up or down slopes, steps, and uneven terrain. We recommend preparing oneself, by walking before the trip. Anyone needing assistance is required to be accompanied by a qualified and physically-able travel companion. We are not responsible for any medical condition that occurs prior, during or after the trip.
